Families who are selected are eligible for reconsideration in futures years; however, no special consideration will be given to previously awarded recipients.

The STAF Board works hard every year to grow the fund so that more students can find an easier financial path to the "St. Ambrose Experience." This is possible through the donations and philanthropic commitment by those in this community.

Administration information

Awarded By: St. Ambrose Forever

Award Amount: Each award will be a minimum of \$1,000 and is non-renewable. The awards will be applied toward tuition and provided directly to the awarded recipients' balance with St. Ambrose School. The awards will be made payable to St. Ambrose Catholic School. No special consideration will be given to previous recipients.

Recipients: For the 2020-2021 school year; multiple awards will be offered. Applicants are selected based on the following criteria: leadership/service; financial need; and scholastic ability. All information collected in the application will be kept confidential. Winners will be notified by **May 20**th.

Deadline Info: All applications must be received by **April 3rd** for consideration.

Eligibility requirements

- Must be enrolled in St. Ambrose Catholic School for the 2020-2021 school year
- Must be in good financial standing with School Administration
- Must be an active parishioner at St. Ambrose Catholic Church
- Must be actively involved in St. Ambrose parish and school activities
- Recipients must disclose any additional scholarship offers. (When recipients receive additional scholarships, those
 additional scholarships will be reviewed in order to ensure that each student receives the full scholarship amount(s) that
 are due. The amount awarded under the St. Ambrose Forever Monsignor Bommarito Fund may be adjusted to avoid
 having a recipient's total award package exceed the Cost of Attendance.)
- Ineligibility: Relatives of the STAF Board members are ineligible to receive the scholarship award.
