St. Ambrose Pre-K 4 End-of-Year Learning Expectations

By the end of the school year, students in Pre-K 4 are expected to demonstrate growth in the following areas:

Language & Early Literacy

- Writes first and last name using recognizable letters
 - Identifies all uppercase letters and most lowercase letters
 - Produces most letter sounds accurately
 - Recognizes and produces beginning sounds in words
 - Identifies and produces rhyming words
 - Demonstrates understanding that print carries meaning
 - Retells familiar stories or events in sequence
 - Speaks in complete sentences to express ideas and needs
 - Follows two- to three-step directions

Mathematics

- Identifies numerals to 20
 - Counts to at least 50
 - Demonstrates one-to-one correspondence when counting
 - Sorts and classifies objects by color, shape, and size
 - Identifies and creates basic patterns (AB, AAB, etc.)
 - Identifies basic shapes
 - Understands concepts such as more/less and same/different
 - Orders numbers or objects in sequence

Social-Emotional Development

- Follows classroom rules and routines with minimal reminders
 - Demonstrates the ability to take turns and share
 - Shows self-control in a variety of settings
 - Interacts appropriately with peers and adults
 - Demonstrates awareness of others' feelings

Approaches to Learning

- Works independently and cooperatively in group settings
 - Demonstrates persistence when completing tasks
 - Engages in problem-solving during play and structured activities
 - Shows curiosity and willingness to try new experiences

Fine & Gross Motor Skills

- Holds and uses scissors appropriately
 - Uses various writing tools with control
 - Demonstrates an appropriate pencil grip
 - Traces and copies basic shapes and lines
 - Participates in movement activities with coordination and balance

Self-Help & Independence

- Packs and unpacks belongings independently
 - Puts on coat and zips independently
 - Manages personal belongings responsibly
 - Follows daily routines with minimal assistance
